


Artists and crafts people open their doors to the public.

Suggestions how to use:

First of all we would suggest you work out which route most people are likely to arrive at your venue, and then work out how many of each sign you need (e.g. pointing left, right or straight on). Then print those out in colour.

The blank area below the words "Artists and crafts people..." is for you to write you name/s, or maybe just 'Open Today'.

In case of rain, we strongly recommend that you then laminate them (best to use the thicker gauge if available). If you do not have a laminating machine your local stationery supplier or print shop should be able to help.

Best way we have found to attach the signs to posts, etc. is to use gaffer tape (preferably white) and electricians cable ties.

Signs are best put up the morning of the event, any earlier and they may well be removed by street cleaners. To be safe, you might also want to take them down Saturday night and re-erect on Sunday morning.
